PLEASE NOTE:

In addition to the main Rules & Regulations, the following rules now apply to the Speech & Drama section.

1. All music is to be on **audio CD only** & this CD should be made available to the sound engineer upon registration for testing. iPods, MP3 players & cassette tapes are not permitted.
2. If you require a piano etc. this **MUST** be specified on the entry form so that adequate arrangements can be made to provide such. Requests made on the day may be declined.
3. All music will be played via the house PA from the rear of the auditorium/control box to enable better balancing of the sound. The use of "ghetto blasters" at the side of the stage, or anywhere in front of the audience, is permitted but you are strongly advised to use the house PA. The Festival will not take responsibility for poor sound production if you choose to use your own equipment in this way. You may operate the PA yourself if you wish.
4. Costume is not permitted. Costume suggestion in Acting classes is permitted where necessary.
5. Performers above Year 13 are regarded as adults.

No performance should contain swearing or obscene language. Any performance that breaks this rule will be immediately disqualified and the performer may, at the discretion of the section head, be required to withdraw from further classes in that section. Performers should avoid using material unsuitable for the age of the performer.

The John Davidson Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the entrant from the Junior Section with the highest aggregate mark from any four solo classes.

The Whymark Trophy will be awarded to the entrant from the Junior Section who, in the opinion of the adjudicator, has achieved a consistently good standard & shows promise, but has not been awarded a first place in a solo class.

The Tenth Anniversary Cup will be awarded to the most outstanding solo performance in the Junior Section (regardless of mark) in the opinion of the adjudicator.

The Clarke-Jervoise Shield will be awarded to the entrant from the Adult Section with the highest aggregate mark from Prose Reading, Sight Reading & Religious Reading.

The Julia Cup will be awarded to the most outstanding performer, in the opinion of the adjudicator, in Class SD G12.

There will be an opportunity for competitors in classes SD123 - SD134 to participate in a Musical Theatre workshop sponsored by Aled Price Productions and led by an industry professional.
